Finally summer season has started! Regular direct flights from various central European countries resumed operations.

Arriving visitors are subject to random Covid 19 testing at arrival, but without mandatory quarantine. Testing at the airport is fairly quick and does so far not cause any delays or inconveniences.

Don't forget to fill your "**Passenger Location Form**" form before travelling, at least 24 hours before your flight. Once on the island, you will be able to enjoy your vacations almost as before, cafeterias, bars, restaurants do not require to wear masks (only supermarkets and public transports does), but of course social distancing (1,5m) is required everywhere to keep all of us safe.
